

## 2025-2026 Returning Student Application Instructions US Citizens and Permanent Residents

**Noncustodial Parent Information:** In an effort to reduce the number of items a student needs to provide, we do not require noncustodial parent information be submitted annually. However, the noncustodial parent has the option of requesting a formal review of their current information. Unless you or your noncustodial parent advise us otherwise, Connecticut College will use last year's application as a basis for determining the 2025-2026 noncustodial contribution. (Note: if the parents divorced or separated since the last time the student applied for aid, we will need the noncustodial parent to complete the CSS Profile Noncustodial Parent Statement and submit their 2023 taxes and W2s to our office. The custodial parent's information should be used to complete the CSS Profile and FAFSA as outlined above.)
